

The District is pleased to announce that we are now accepting applications for 2022. This program will help to cover costs associated with conservation practices such as fences or grass seedings just to name a few.

One example where this program might fit into your operation is cover crops. Not fully on board with cover crops, this program allows you to try them on a small scale and not be locked into a huge contract.

All applications are reviewed by the board at their monthly meetings and once approved the applicant has one year to complete the project from the date of approval. The maximum amount per

contract is \$5,000 and is based off of our partner agency NRCS pay rates. The max number of contracts allowed per person is two in a lifetime. If you have any questions feel free to call the office and receive assistance for any questions or conservation planning that you might need. The applications can be obtained at our office, Facebook Page, and Website (wmcoscd.com).
