New incentive payments now available for newly planted grass and CRP

\$80/ACRE

Program will provide pheasants with high-quality nesting and brood-rearing habitat with additional walk-in hunting access. New grass plantings will also support many other wildlife species.



NEW GRASS PLANTINGS THROUGH NORTH DAKOTA GAME AND FISH DEPARTMENT



One-time habitat enhancement payments

\$30/acre NDGF Habitat Incentive

\$50/acre Pheasants Forever Incentive

\$80/acre total incentives

Annual Rental rates **\$45/acre**

\$60/acre Grass Establishment Payment
(grass seed will be provided)

Example:

A 160-acre grass planting would receive:

\$12,800 one-time incentive payment

\$7,200 annual rental payment

\$9,600 grass establishment payment

NEWLY PLANTED GRASS ENROLLED IN CRP



One-time habitat enhancement payments

\$30/acre NDGF Habitat Incentive

\$50/acre Pheasants Forever Incentive

\$80/acre total incentives

\$10/acre access payments

Example:

A 160-acre grass planting would receive:

\$12,800 one-time incentive payment

\$16,000 up-front access payment (10-years)

+FSA rental payment for CRP



PLOTS

- All agreements receiving habitat incentives must be enrolled in PLOTS.
- PLOTS is an agreement between the private landowner and the North Dakota Game and Fish Department that requires walk-in public access for hunting on private land.
- Typical agreements for lands receiving habitat incentives are 10 years in length.
- Prescribed haying allowed on new grass plantings through North Dakota Game and Fish.
- Technical assistance provided.
